Glacier Gorge's "Hole in the Wall" restaurant provides a diverse selection of quick-service items, from hearty barbecue to light salads and healthy proteins. Guests can relax under vaulted cave ceilings and stalagmite/stalactite columns lit by colorful flood lights. Small waterfalls create soft ambient noise to reduce echoes and immerse guests in the cavern dining experience.

SABERTOOTH PEAK

Embark on a thrilling adventure and brave the fierce wilderness.



Flagship attraction "Sabertooth Peak" is a massive family roller coaster that mixes fact and fiction to tell the story of a young boy on a quest to explore the lands beyond his village. The coaster merges dark-ride storytelling with a thrilling adventure ride, guiding guests over the icy hills of Glacier Gorge, between twisting stalactites, and into the depths of crystal caves.

"Sabertooth Peak" has interactions with many major locations in the park including the entrances to the park, the restaurant, and the family water and cave exploration area. These interactions connect major areas of the park together to create a more cohesive themed experience.



Roaming Queue Experience



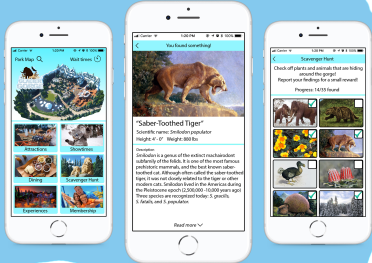
"Sabertooth Peak's" novel queue technology incorporates a free roaming queue area. Guests are given "Spirit Stones," interactive queue management devices that hold their position while they explore a wealth of RFID interactive elements scattered around the queue. The Spirit Stone aids in queue logistics and allows guests to stay engaged with the narrative of the roller coaster while they wait to board the ride.

Flora & Fauna Scavenger Hunt

Learn about Delaware's native fauna and the animals of North America's past.

Glacier Gorge's mobile application encourages exploration of the park and preservation of the Chesapeake Bay through a scavenger hunt. When guests complete the scavenger hunt by finding native plants and animals scattered around the park, they earn a souvenir pin from retail locations. Through the app, guests can also view the map, wait times, and additional

The exploration area features stepping stones zigzagging across streams, bursting geysers to cool down, and a maze of tunnels and caves the whole family can explore.



The tunnels and caves feature waterfalls and volcanic formations common during the Ice Age. Guests can press buttons integrated into the scenery to trigger similar special effects as those found in the queue area of Sabertooth Peak.

The main retail store is situated near the main entrance/exit of Glacier Gorge. It is the first and last major experience guests visit in Glacier Gorge. Here, guests can purchase merchandise that is both respectful and playful to the history of the Neanderthals including toy bows and arrows, wooden staves, and stuffed animals.

Riders exiting or near the exit of the "Sabertooth Peak" roller coaster can explore a secondary retail location themed as a village of huts. It carries the same merchandise as the main retail store as well as "Sabertooth Peak" specific merchandise and pictures.

ice paintings

Experience a nighttime spectacle featuring wonders of nature and the magic of cave art.



At night, guests watch in wonder as the lagoon's glaciers come to life in "Ice Paintings." Guests join the storyteller from Sabertooth Peak as she recounts how Ice Age adventurers Allu and Zot discovered the magic of cave paintings. Walkways surrounding the lagoon provide nearly 360-degree viewing. Projection mapping technology and programmable fountains create the illusion of ice falling and cave paintings coming to life. Iceberg rafts will carry puppets and supporting actors in animal costumes that support the narrative. The adventure culminates in a message of preserving the magic that lives in cave art and natural ice formations.

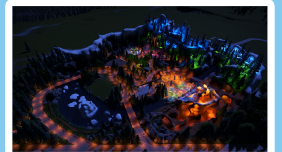
night experiences

As the sun sets on Glacier Gorge, colorful lights illuminate the hillsides and transform the natural terrain into a brilliant gemstone. As guests continue to explore familiar attractions, they will find the park changes with the night.
